Singing is an activity that relates to human expression. It is not only powerful and a fundamental mode of expression but is also an integral part of music education. Singing is ever present in all schools' music textbooks, thus making it a major component in school's music curriculum and co-curricular activities.

Zoltán Kodály (1882-1967), a prominent Hungarian composer, musician, teacher, linguist, and ethnomusicologist, believed that the easiest way to reach a large number of people and to connect them with "genuine, valuable music is through singing". This well-known Hungarian music educator said:

Teach music and singing in school in such a way that it is not a torture but a joy for the pupil;... This experience cannot be left to chance; it is the duty of the school to provide it. (Kodaly, 1929)
